My steps are ordered by the lord. (Psalm 37:23)

Theme:

Knowing and trusting in God's will for our lives.

READ:

Psalm 37:23-24

Psalm 119:105

Jeremiah 29:11

Ephesians 1:1-5

REFLECTION:

Understanding that God has a plan for your life can be very comforting. It helps you to realize that you are not alone and you don't have the pressure of figuring everything out. As long as you devote your life to Him, He will order your steps. Knowing this can bring great confidence to you and your family.

In the scriptures today, you will discover a few things:

1. If you are walking with the Lord, He will lead you and guide you.
2. His word will light up the paths that are dark or unknown in our lives.
3. Our future He has planned is a future of hope, success, and prosperity. We just need to follow Him!
4. He chose us before the foundation of the world to adopt us as His own sons and daughters and has given us every spiritual blessing.

I encourage you to take time to read over the scriptures. Highlight a few keys for each verse. Ask questions like:

"Who is this scripture referring to?"

"Is there a promise I can hold on to?"

"How do I need to change my mind to start trusting in God's plan?"

There are a lot of unsure things in life. But God's plan for our lives is not one of them. We only need to follow His lead and allow His Word to be the lamp we follow.

CHALLENGE:

Encourage your family to learn to listen to God's voice and His Word today. Before making a decision, ask the Lord for His guidance. Learn to obey His voice by lining it up with the Word in our thoughts, our words, and our actions. Declare, "My steps are ordered by the Lord!"
