

DAY 9

I expect to have divine appointments today, to run into the right people, and to be delivered from the wrong people.

Theme:

Knowing God is with us and His plans are for good not evil.

READ:

Psalm 23:1-4

Romans 8:28

Acts 5:12, 17-23, 25-29

REFLECTION:

It's important to understand that God is good. And His plans for us are good. When we look around the world today, we must hold to the fact that God is truly with us and is making a way **out of** things and is making a way **to** some things.

As you read over the scriptures in Psalm and Romans, make a list of the things God will do for you. After you make the list (see example below), talk about each thing and what it means. Then, read the story in Acts where God delivers the disciples and leads them right back to the place they were arrested. Talk about trust in God!!! Can you imagine being thrown into prison for preaching the gospel in a certain city, get thrown in jail, escape jail, and then go right back to preaching in the same city?! That's trusting God!

Example of a list:

1. He is my shepherd and will lead me today
 2. He leads me to sustainment (green pastures).
 3. He leads me to peace (still waters)
 4. He restores my mind, will, and emotions.
 5. He leads me down right paths
- (etc...)

Courage each other with the goodness of God.

CHALLENGE:

Have everyone share a moment in their life where they felt God's divine intervention (where God steps in) It's good to hear the testimonies of God's goodness. Now, when you go about your day, don't look at people in your life as the enemy, but look at the assignment for your life to be right where God has you!
